# 1 - KA07 - Gender history of spa treatment, institutionalization, and creation of expert knowledge in the transnational context in 19th and 20th century

## Job description and the Research field

The postdoctoral researcher will carry out research in the field of history focusing on history of medicine, particularly the historical development of spa, and implications of gender analysis in the institutionalization of spa, creation of expert knowledge in balneology and medical practice in transnational perspective throughout the 19th and 20th century. In terms of research field, the research will be part of the national RIS3 area called Social Sciences for Non-technical Innovation; on the regional level, it will fall under an applied research area called Medicine, Biotechnology and Healthcare Equipment and Life Sciences. The postdoctoral researcher will contribute with his or her experience in interdisciplinary comparative research in Sociology, Anthropology and History of Medicine, as well as his or her international publication activities and an extensive network of international research contacts. The involvement of the postdoctoral researcher may be a great asset for the research team of the Department of History at the Faculty of Arts and Philosophy that will be implementing a project funded by the Czech Science Foundation (GAČR) between 2020 and 2022 called Making of a Doctor: Formation of physician and patient role and the history of the patient-physician relationship in Czech lands 1769 - 1992. The candidate will participate in PhD workshops or seminars organised by the Department and take part in research project activities and cooperate on planning of international conference preparation.

Research Field: History.

#### Objectives and expected benefits

This stay aims at enhancing the cooperation of the Department of History with a renowned international research institution. The involvement of the postdoctoral researcher will follow up on the existing activities of the academic team who have been specializing in the history of human body and social history of medicine for a long time. Therefore, the researcher's mentor will be prof. PhDr. Milena Lenderová, CSc. Thanks to the involvement of the postdoctoral researcher in the preparation and organization of an international conference focused on interdisciplinary research into therapeutic and diagnostic medical methods (spring 2022), the researcher will also help establish contacts with key international institutions in this field. The direct cooperation with the research team of the GAČR project that focuses on the history of medicine will contribute to the direct transfer of transnational knowledge of comparative methods used for analysing the historical development of medicine into the Czech research community.

#### Requirements

- Ph.D. or its international equivalent (ISCED Level 8) awarded not earlier than 7 years before the beginning of the mobility<sup>1</sup>,
- over the past 3 years, the candidate has spent a minimum of 2 continuous years (as of the beginning of the mobility) outside the Czech Republic working as a researcher (with FTE of 0.5 and more) or did PhD studies abroad;
- over the past 3 years the candidate has published a minimum of 2 papers (as of the beginning of the mobility) in journals indexed in Thomson Reuters Web of Science, Scopus or ERIH PLUS databases.

All of the documents must be submitted in English. A university diploma or a decision on its recognition and a language exam certificate may also be submitted in Czech or Slovak. If an original of a document is not in Czech, Slovak or English, an official translation into one of these languages is required. A certified copy is not required for the purposes of the selection procedure, a printed or an electronic (pdf) one is sufficient.
