Rector's Student Award in the 2023/2024 Academic Year: Conditions and Amount

- 1) The Rector grants the Student Award to final-year students in full-time Master's programmes for excellent study results as foreseen by Article 4(1)(b) of the Scholarship Regulations of the University of Pardubice.
- 2) There are two categories of the Students Award. The Rector will decide on the Students Awards for excellent study results based on the proposals submitted by the deans.
- 3) A proposal to grant the Rector's Student Award must comply with the following conditions:
 - a) **Category 1 Rector's Student Award** – granted for overall study results “with distinction” and an excellent quality of a diploma thesis based on the proposal of the dean of the respective faculty.
 - b) **Category 2 Rector's Student Award** – granted for an excellent quality of a diploma thesis based on the proposal of the dean of the respective faculty.
- 4) Scholarship in the amount of **CZK 40,000** is granted for Category 1 Rector's Student Award. Scholarship in the amount of **CZK 20,000** is granted for Category 2 Rector's Student Award.
- 5) For the 2023/2024 academic year, a maximum of 7 Category 1 awards and 21 Category 2 awards are expected to be granted.
- 6) The awarded students will receive the Student Award diploma at their graduation ceremony. Subsequently, the scholarship will be transferred to the student's bank account specified in the IS STAG system.
- 7) This Rector's Announcement comes into force and effect on 11 December 2023.
