The amount of the merit scholarship for the academic year 2023/2024

In accordance with the provisions under Article 8(4) of the Scholarship Regulations of the University of Pardubice, I hereby set the amount of the merit scholarship for the academic year 2023/2024 for students who:

(1) achieve in the academic year 2022/2023:

- (a) a weighted average of 1.00 to 1.20 – in the amount of **CZK 3,000/month**
- (b) a weighted average of 1.21 to 1.50 – in the amount of **CZK 1,000/month**

and who also meet the conditions for awarding a merit scholarship for outstanding academic performance stipulated under Article 4(2) of the Scholarship Regulations of the University of Pardubice.

(2) The merit scholarship shall be awarded to the top 5% of students enrolled in full-time Bachelor's study programmes out of the total number of students studying in full-time Bachelor's study programmes as of 31 October 2023, excluding students coming for a short-term study stay within each faculty.

(3) The merit scholarship shall be awarded to the top 10% of students enrolled in full-time Master's study programmes out of the total number of students studying in full-time Bachelor's study programmes as of 31 October 2023, excluding students coming for a short-term study stay within each faculty.

(4) The Rector's Announcement shall come into force and effect on 2 December 2022.
