## Article 1 Introductory Provisions

1. Owing to the experience gained during the spread of COVID-19 in the Czech Republic, the Rector issues this measure to stipulate the possibility of on-line education within the study programmes in full-time and combined forms of study.

## Article 2 Education Possibilities in the Academic Year 2020/2021

1. In connection with the current measures of the Czech government, the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic or the Regional Health Authority, which aim to restrict contact education (i.e. education based on physical presence of students), it is possible to realize the education of study subjects (the "subjects") on-line or in a hybrid form combining contact education and the tools for its on-line transmission.
2. Although on-line education follows the same rules as the contact one, it is entirely based on various technologies for remote communication.
3. On-line or hybrid forms of education are mainly realized for lectures, practical lessons, or seminars which otherwise, under standard circumstances, usually take place either in lecture halls or classrooms.
4. On-line or hybrid forms of education usually take place on the same days and times as planned contact teaching of the academic year 2020/2021.
5. The subjects based on practical education, which mainly take place in laboratories, studios, or technical classrooms, follow current measures and possible regulations as to the maximum number of students at the time and place for the contact form of education.
6. In connection herewith, the faculties shall specify their own conditions for teaching in the academic year 2020/2021. Considering the real external circumstances limiting their operation, each faculty shall assess particularly the degree of risk of contact education in individual subjects and decide individually whether the given subject or a part thereof shall be taught in a non-contact manner. In doing so, they shall take into account, for example, the size of the study group, the size of the lecture room, and the nature of the subject.

7. Non-contact education shall be monitored and regularly evaluated by the faculties, both from the point of students and teachers. Such evaluation shall serve as a feedback to the teachers so that they could improve their teaching and remove possible shortcomings.

**Final provisions**

1. This measure becomes valid and effective on the day it is signed by the Rector.
