**Article 1**  
**Initial Provision**

- 1) In connection with COVID-19 occurrence caused by the new coronavirus SARSCoV-2 in the Czech Republic, to protect health of employees and students and to prevent the spread of the disease, the Rector of the University of Pardubice ("the University") introduced the following provisions effective from 17 September 2020.

**Article 2 2**  
**Special Legal Regulations, Current Limitations**

- 1) The University of Pardubice follows legal regulations and provisions of the Ministry of Health and of other public administration authorities introduced in connection with the coronavirus pandemic, as amended.
- 2) Students, employees and persons with symptoms of infectious disease (e.g. fever, cough, dyspnea, loss of sense of smell and taste, weakness, etc.) are forbidden to enter the University premises.
- 3) Conditions for education and operations at the University will be adjusted and communicated in the news section of the University Intranet. Contact lessons at the University are limited to a maximum of 50 persons in one room. Deans of particular faculties will specify methods and organisation of education in compliance with the current situation.
- 4) The Rector hereby requests that deans of individual faculties and other concerned managers within their competences follow the up-to-date information on the Intranet or Internet of the University and the generally binding regulations of the state administration bodies. Consequently, the deans implement and communicate such regulations to their students and employees and to other concerned persons.
- 5) With effect from 14 September 2020, employees may, upon agreement with the relevant supervising person, work from home in compliance with Directive 8/2020 "Home Office" in the event of quarantine and in other justified events, if the relevant job nature allows such work.
- 6) Employees and students who stayed for over 12 hours in the period of the last 14 days in a country which is not listed among the low risk COVID-19 countries published by the Ministry of Health, shall be obliged to inform the head of their department and the Human Resources about this fact. Students report to the Study Office of the particular faculty, and until submitting a negative test performed in the Czech Republic or after the quarantine period, they are prevented from entering all the University premises and classrooms.
- 7) The Rector appeals to all employees and students of the University of Pardubice to pay special attention to all hygienic measures and to proceed in compliance with the generally binding legal regulations of the state administration bodies.

**Article 3**  
**Final Provisions**

- 1) The Provision becomes valid by the Rector's signature and is effective from 17 September 2020.
