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1. PREAMBLE

The Implementation Schedule of the Strategic Plan of the University of Pardubice for 2021 (the "Strategic Plan of the University for 2021") represents a concretisation of the Strategic Plan of the University of Pardubice for the period from 2021 (the "Strategic Plan of the University"). The document follows the Strategic Plan of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports (the "MEYS") for higher education for the period from 2021 and the Strategy for the Internationalisation of Higher Education for the period from 2021.

The Institutional Plan of the University of Pardubice for 2021 is detailed in Annex 2. Outline of the Investment Activities Plan of the University of Pardubice for 2021 (Annex 3) represents a concretisation of Plan of Investment Activities of the University of Pardubice for 2021-2030 (the "Plan of Investment Activities of the University for 2021-2030").

2. STRATEGIC PRIORITIES, PRIORITY OBJECTIVES AND INDICATORS

The Strategic Plan of the University aims to increase the quality of all activities of the University and its individual parts, which will strengthen the position of the University of Pardubice on a national and international scale and fulfil the mission and vision of the University and all its ambitions.

At the university level, the implementation of the Strategic Plan of the University focuses on improving the quality of institutional support systems and university-wide strategic management using all tools to improve activities and achieve the set goals. It concretises the support of central university units and the system of university-wide quality monitoring in direct cooperation with all faculties.

At the faculty level, it aims mainly to strengthen the quality of the implementation of its own educational, scientific research and other creative activities and their internationalisation.

In accordance with the set vision, The Strategic Plan of the University contains five strategic priorities focused on the development of educational activities, research and creative activities, human resources, internationalisation and its traditions and brands.

- Priority 1: Competences of students for the 21st century
- Priority 2: High-standard and respected scientific research and creative activities
- Priority 3: People are most important for the quality and sustainable development of our University
- Priority 4: International dimension of the University of Pardubice adequate for the 21st century
- Priority 5: Our common identity: long tradition, 7 faculties, one brand

For each of the five priorities, a vision, strategic priorities (P), specific activities (A) and indicators (I) are defined. The individual activities are linked to the operational objective of the Strategic Plan of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports for higher education for the period from 2021 (e.g. SP 1A) and the Strategy for the Internationalisation of Higher Education for the period from 2021 (e.g. SI 1A). This fact is part of the Strategic Plan of the University.

3. IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE OF THE STRATEGIC PLAN OF THE UNIVERSITY OF PARDUBICE FOR 2021

The purpose of this document is to define the main strategies for 2021, which fulfil the visions of the University of Pardubice set out in the Strategic Plan of the University. This definition takes into account the links to educational and scientific research projects carried out, as well as to the Institutional Programme for Public Higher Education Institutions for 2021 and Centralized Development Projects for 2021. The interconnection with the Plan of Investment Activities of the University for 2021-2030 is also obvious.

In 2021, attention will be paid to all five strategic priorities for the development of the University of Pardubice and the activities defined, as they complement and condition each other in order to achieve the overall vision of the University of Pardubice. The following section lists the main objectives set for 2021, including the respective strategic priorities.

Where relevant, a link to funding from the Institutional Programme for Public Higher Education Institutions for 2021 (e.g. IPR Ox, where x is the measure number).

Priority 1: Competences of students for the 21st century

In 2021, all strategic priorities will be continuously fulfilled and implemented.

- P1.1 Implementing the quality of study programmes at an internationally competitive level.
- **P1.2** Developing the quality of study programmes with an emphasis on the use of acquired knowledge and skills in the labour market and more intensive interaction with the industry and business spheres.
- P1.3 New technologies, supports and facilities for the implementation of education adequate to the 21st century.
- P1.4 Strengthening the global competencies of students necessary for their employment in the labour market.
- P1.5 Strengthening the quality and internationalisation of doctoral studies.

- Internal development fund for university-wide support to strategic activities of faculties in the field of educational activities, which will help increase the quality of study programmes in the field (A6-1) of new teaching methods relevant in the 21st century and interactive teaching methods linked to the transfer of information and knowledge from the industry and business spheres, (A6-2) on-line forms of education or (A6-3) subjects taught in a foreign language with an emphasis on the joint participation of Czech and foreign students in the lessons (A6-3). (A6-1: SZ 1C, A6-2: SZ 2A, A6-3: SI 2A; IRP O4)
- Setting up a university-wide methodological interpretation describing each new teaching methods, which the university management identifies as essential for the development of teaching and study programmes. For those, best practices for their implementation will be provided. (P1.3, IRP O1)
- Setting up a university-wide concept of professional support and continuous education of academic staff in the area of key competencies for modern teaching with the use of the internal information system Employee Education Portal. (P1.3, IRP O1)
- Setting up a university-wide methodological interpretation describing the individual "on-line" forms of education, which the university management identifies as essential from the point of view of the development of teaching and study programmes. They will be provided with recommended implementation procedures. (P1.3, IRP O2)
- Setting up a university-wide concept of professional support and continuous education of academic staff in the field of key competencies for "on-line" forms of education, using, among other things, online video tutorials and the internal information system Employee Education Portal. (P1.3, IRP O2)
- Innovation of centralised English language teaching. (P1.4, IRP O6)
- Innovation of the system of creating analytical reports and the concept of strategic management of educational activities. (P1.6, IRP O4)

Person in charge: Vice-Rector for Research and Development

- Setting up a university-wide high-standard system for doctoral study programmes. (P1.5, IRP O3)
- Setting up a university-wide methodology to support doctoral students. (P1.5, IRP O3)
- Setting up a university-wide system of offering Czech language courses for foreign students of doctoral study programmes. (P1.5, IRP O3)
- Setting up a university-wide system of joint workshops for students of doctoral study programmes. (P1.5, IRP O3)

Priority 2: High-standard and respected scientific research and creative activity

In 2021, all strategic priorities will be continuously fulfilled and implemented.

- **P2.1** Improving the R&D&I quality evaluation system and setting up a system of direct connection to financing, strategic management and self-reflection.
- **P2.2** Development of high-quality or strategic scientific disciplines linked mainly to the field of education with accreditation granted for doctoral studies.

- Formulation of the framework, strategy of the University of Pardubice and tools for fulfilling the principles of open science across all scientific disciplines taught at the University of Pardubice in accordance with the scientific policy of the Czech Republic. (P2.9)

Annex 2 Focus of the Institutional Plan of the University of Pardubice for 2021

Focus of the Institutional Plan of the University of Pardubice for 2021

The Institutional Plan of the University of Pardubice for 2021 is a summary of nine measures, based on the current internal state of the institution, are in line with the mission and vision of the university for 2030, reflect current extraordinary external circumstances and contribute to the priority goals of the Strategic Plan of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports for the period from 2021.

The Institutional Plan of the University of Pardubice for 2021 is focused on supporting the quality of educational activities (Measures 1 to Measure 3), development of strategic management (Measure 4), development of project support (Measure 5), development of the internationalisation process (Measures 6 to 8) and strengthening social integrity of students (Measure 9).

Support for the quality of education is focused on the development of "new" (Measure 1) and flexible (Measure 2) forms of education. To this end, it is necessary to provide high-standard technical and professional support (Measure 1, Measure 2). Within both measures, a clear definition of the importance of individual forms of teaching and the development of an adequate support system is envisaged. The Covid-19 pandemic in 2020 brought an unprecedented situation with an exceptional impact on the daily lives of society as a whole. Distance learning has become a common part of education at all levels of education, all actors were forced to learn to use new technologies and methods of education in a short time. It is for this reason that it seems sensible to use the experience and competences thus acquired and to focus on the sustainable development of the quality of online forms of education as a complementary tool of the educational process, depending on the nature of the subject and study programme.

Although doctoral studies can be considered the pinnacle of educational activities, relatively lower support is directed to this area for 2021 within the Institutional Plan of the University of Pardubice for 2021, which, however, in a very specific way aims to support the involvement of foreign experts in opposition proceedings (Measure 3). At present, a number of support measures are focused on doctoral studies, however, in order to increase the effectiveness of their impact on students, it is necessary to support the development of a university-wide quality system in 2021 so that all future measures lead to a most efficient use of funds and reduction of study fail rate.

Emphasis will also be placed on the development of strategic management and a university-wide quality system based on data (Measure 4). A clear-cut goal is to build on the external evaluation processes that the University has undergone in recent years (e.g. MEP, MICHE and M17 +), to take into account the conclusions of the evaluation and to support the processes leading to the further development of our University. Therefore, a very specific goal is to support specific activities at the level of specific subjects and study programmes that will meet the strategic goals of the faculties (Measure 5).

The priority for the future is also the support of obtaining funding for science and research, both in the field of basic and applied research. To do this, it is necessary to build the capacity of adequate project support, which is absolutely essential, especially in the case of foreign providers (Measure 5).

Internationalisation (Measures 6, 7 and 8) is mainly related to the development of the University's bilingual environment, which is absolutely essential from the point of view of the admission of foreign students and staff, and therefore the further development of the University. The only measure that targets the so-called "other measures" is to strengthen the social integrity of students (Measure 9).
