### The Amount of the Merit Scholarship for the Academic Year 2022/2023

In accordance with the provisions under Article 8(4) of the Scholarship Regulations of the University of Pardubice, I hereby set the amount of the merit scholarship for the academic year 2022/2023 for students who:

1. achieve in the academic year 2021/2022:

- a) a weighted average of 1.00 to 1.20 – in the amount of ..... **CZK 3,000/month**
- b) a weighted average of 1.21 to 1.50 – in the amount of ..... **CZK 1,000/month**

and who also meet the conditions for awarding a merit scholarship for outstanding academic performance stipulated under Article 4(2) of the Scholarship Regulations of the University of Pardubice.

2. The merit scholarship shall be awarded to the top 5% of students enrolled in full-time Bachelor's study programmes, out of the total number of students studying in full-time Bachelor's study programmes as of 31 October 2022, excluding students coming for short-term study stays within each faculty.
3. The merit scholarship shall be awarded to the top 10% of students enrolled in full-time Master's study programmes, out of the total number of students studying in full-time Bachelor's study programmes as of 31 October 2022, excluding students coming for short-term study stays within each faculty.
4. This measure shall come into force and effect on 24 November 2021.
